SECRET SCROLLS

Continuing the theme of changes is plot in this edition of Secret Scrolls I will talk about the difference between Yugi's deck and Neferi's

It's pretty easy to see that there are some significant differences between Yugi's deck and Neferi's, as well as a lot of similarities. I didn't want the changes to be too dramatic, so that it was still recognizable, but I also wanted Neferi's deck to reflect that fact that she was female and did have a different personality than Yugi



Yugi's deck is fundamentally a Spellcaster/Fiend deck, with a few random Warriors and Beast type cards thrown in. He also has a huge collection of some of the rarest Spell and Trap cards in the game. I definitely had to keep the Spellcaster aspect, as well as the focus on the Dark Magician. Because let's face it, not only is DM a cool looking and strong card, he does have a lot to do with the plot of the story.

Neferi's deck is a Spellcaster/Fairy deck, also with a few Beasts and Warriors thrown in. She also focuses a lot on strong Traps and Spells (Thanks Alita) but with the exception of a few cards, most of hers are not very rare. One of the luxuries of the YGO card game is the fact that probably 90% cards produced have never showed up in any of the three series, leaving me a lot of great cards to pick from.

So why such a focus on Fairy-types? Well, I'm going to tip my hand and bit and say Fairy cards are probably my favorite cards of the game, and many of the cards Neferi uses are ones I've used in my own personal deck for tournaments. But I figure a cute girl with cute cards wouldn't be too objected to for Neferi.



I'm very much looking forward to presenting the Battle City arc to all of you, so that way you'll be able to see the further similarities and differences between Neferi's deck and Yugi's
