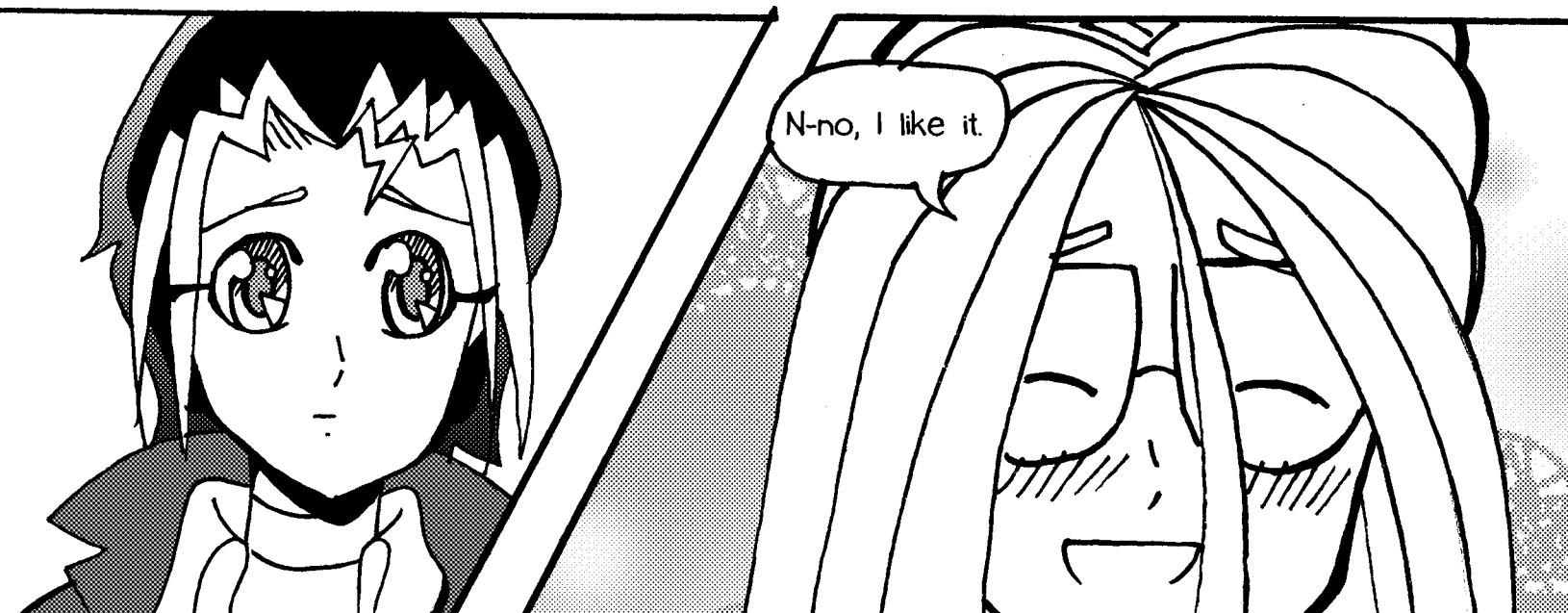
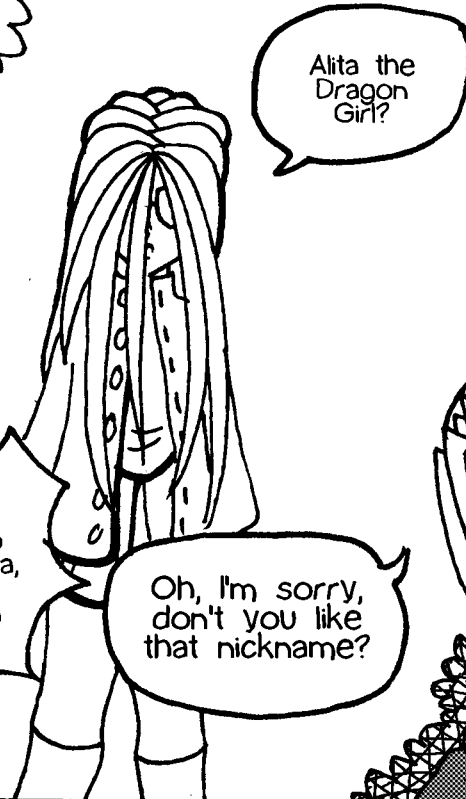
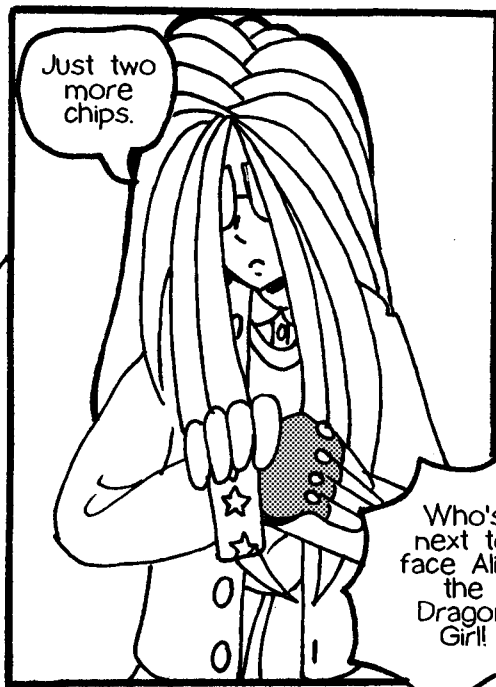
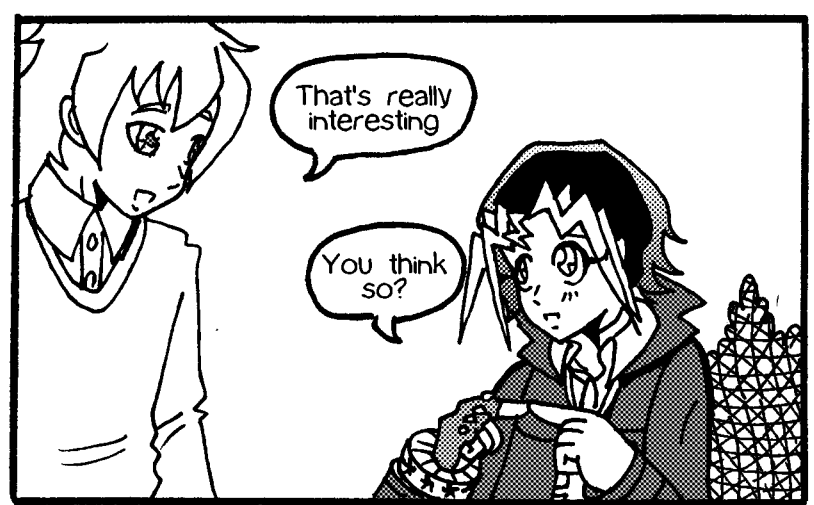
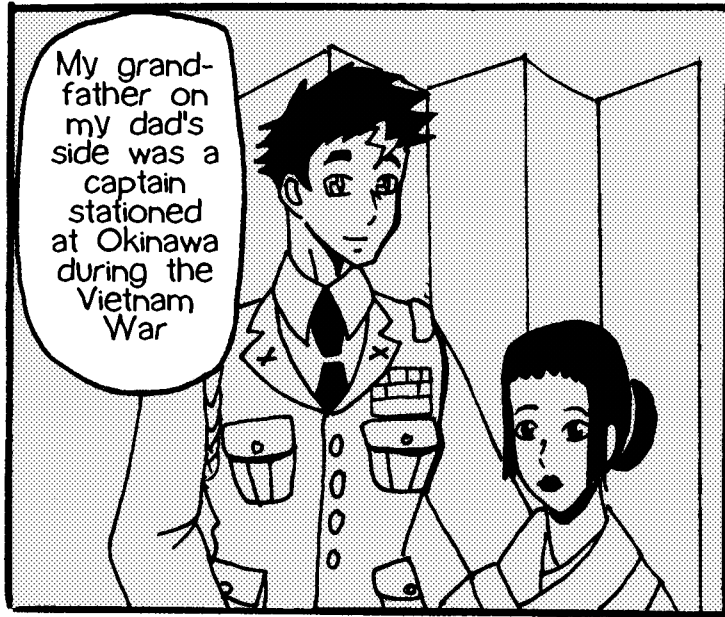








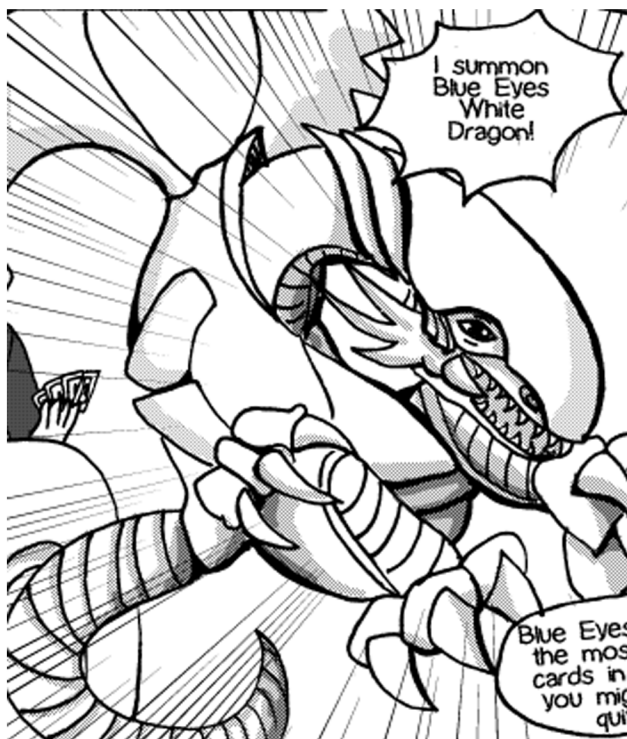




SECRET SCROLLS

Welcome back to the Secret Scrolls! As I promised in the last issue, I will talk about Alita's deck, and its huge focus on dragons.

The first hint that Alita had a dragon deck goes back to 'Thief of Souls' when Alita lends Neferi her Lord of D., as many players will know is a card that prevents Dragon-type monsters from getting negatively affected by the opponents Traps and Magic cards. Also, Alita mentions she had *two* favorite cards, with Lord of D. being one, what was the other?



The correct answer, of course, is Blue Eyes White Dragon. In the original Yugi-Oh the fourth dragon belonged to Yugi's grandfather, but I never revealed who had the card in this universe. Kaiba's hatred of Yugi started over Yugi beating him when Kaiba destroyed the fourth dragon and hurt Yugi's grandfather. In this version Kaiba's contempt for Neferi was over Alita's *store* not her *card*.

So why does Alita get to keep her dragon as opposed to losing it like Solomon Motou? Well there are 3 major plot points associated with Alita, Kaiba, the Blue Eyes, Battle Angel and KaibaCorp. All of which will eventually be revealed in the series, starting with Chapter 14. And as for dragons in general as being Alita's theme, it only made sense with her already having the Blue Eyes.
